The ANBMT has been incorporated since 1994 as an organization representing massage therapists in this province.

Standards for admission to the association are rigorous. The ANBMT is an Association of Registered Massage Therapists that uses competency standards and accepts massage therapists with training accepted by the CMTO (College of Massage Therapists of Ontario). All members must graduate from a school with a curriculum accepted by a province with provincially legislated standards for practice (Ontario, British Columbia, Newfoundland & Labrador).

The ANBMT has an elected Board as well as a constitution, code of ethics and bylaws that establish the scope of practice and ethical considerations for its members.
