Important Information Regarding Affiliate Membership

- Affiliate Membership is granted to an individual, group or organization, business or corporation that has an interest in the advancement of the profession of massage therapy and in furthering the Association’s purposes; and
- Has an interest in the activities, well-being, role and function of the Association;
- Intends to contribute to and be affiliated with the profession of massage therapy;
- Affiliate Membership is not a license to practise massage therapy; this does not grant an applicant the ability to access the ANBMT’s professional liability insurance program through Lackner McLennan Insurance.**
- Affiliate Members may attend those seminars or workshops that are identified as open to All Members at the preferential rate determined by the Association for Affiliate Membership;
- Prior to becoming an Affiliate member, the applicant must sign a memorandum of understanding that:**
 - The member understands they are to only represent themselves as an affiliate member of the Association;
 - The member agrees to support and promote the objectives of the Association;
 - The member understands that they are required to comply with the governing documents of the Association; and
 - The member understands that they are not allowed in any manner whatsoever to deceive the public and they are required to disclose the fact that they are not a Practising member/Registered with the provincial Association or regulatory College of the jurisdiction that they are working within.
